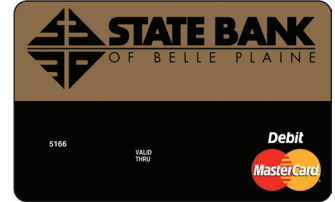

- Notify the issuing bank of the dates and location of your travel plans to avoid any potential denials or fraud alerts when out-of-the-ordinary transactions are presented. This is especially crucial for international travel. Due to the increase in international fraud, our customers' debit cards are blocked from international transactions, unless we receive a travel notification.

- Make sure your bank has your current contact information in case they need to get a hold of you.
 - Make copies of all the cards you'll be carrying. Take a copy with you and give a copy to someone you trust at home. Include the customer service phone number for each card.
 - Check your available balances before you leave. Know the limits for cash withdrawals and purchases. Contact your bank if you wish to make any changes before you go.
